

Polkomtel, Orange Polska, P4 and T-Mobile Polska have submitted initial bids in 5G auction – UKE

UKE has announced that Poland's four major mobile operators: Polkomtel (Polsat Plus Group), Orange Polska, P4 and T-Mobile Polska, have submitted initial bids in the President of UKE's auction of frequencies in the 3.6 GHz band (the so-called C-band).

The starting price for each of the four frequency reservations put up for auction is PLN 450 million.

According to the auction requirements, its winners will be required, among other things, to launch at least 3,800 base stations within 48 months from the date of delivery of the reservation, to cover 85% of the country's area with 30 Mbps capacity within 12 months, and then to increase capacity and coverage to 95 Mbps and 90% of the country's area, respectively, within 60 months.

T-Mobile Polska's Q2 '23 revenue increased by 2.7 percent and EBITDAaL by 0.2 percent

T-Mobile Polska reported Q2 2023 revenues of PLN 1.66 billion (+2.7% YoY) and EBITDA after lease costs (EBITDAaL) of PLN 466 million (+0.2%).

The operator pointed out in a press release the impact of continued significant cost increases on operations, which resulted in a discrepancy between revenue growth and EBITDAaL. At the same time, it highlighted the stabilization of the result in the second quarter of this year thanks to the commissioning of the first green energy farms, which partially mitigated the effect of rising electricity costs, and a good commercial performance.

At the end of June 2023, T-Mobile Polska's customer base totaled 12.460 million customers (+2.9% YoY). This included a contract customer base of 8.092 million (+2.0% YoY), and a prepaid customer base of 4.368 million (+4.6% YoY).

Polsat closes down free streaming service

The free streaming platform Polsat Go will end its operations at the end of August this year.

Existing Polsat Go users will get free access to the new Polsat Box Go Start package for two months.

"We have decided to shut down Polsat Go, and our content will be offered, among others, in the new Polsat Box Go Start package in the subscription-advertising model - a low promotional fee of PLN 30 for the whole year and a small number of commercials. This is in line with the current trend in the streaming market," said Stanislaw Janowski, president of Polsat Television, quoted in the press release.

Cyfrowy Polsat expects net debt/EBITDA to increase in '23 and '24 due to investments

During a conference call on the results of the second quarter of this year, the management of Cyfrowy Polsat (Polsat Plus Group) said that due to ongoing investments in the renewables segment, it expects the net debt/EBITDA ratio to increase further in 2023 and 2024.

"We are in the midst of very large investments, which are expected to bring us EBITDA and considerable profits in the future.(...) As long as these investments last, this ratio will grow. We expect it to grow next year as well. On the other hand, starting in 2025, we expect to start deleveraging and see this ratio decline," reported Katarzyna Ostap-Tomann, Management Board member for Finance.

At the end of the first half of the year, the group's net EBITDA LTM debt increased to 3.26x from 2.86x at the end of 2022.

In the second half of 2023, the group expects a positive contribution to the results from PAK-PCE Group.

In line with its strategy, Polsat Plus Group is making investments in clean energy production, particularly from the sun, wind, biomass and thermal waste treatment, as well as entering the hydrogen economy. The Group intends to invest about PLN 5 billion to achieve a total of 1,000 MW of clean energy generation capacity, and PLN 0.5 billion in hydrogen technologies.

In the second quarter of this year, test production was launched at wind farms in Miłosław and Kazimierz Biskupi.

Serial production at a new hydrogen bus factory (with an annual output of 100 buses) is expected to start in September. Also in September, the commercial opening of the first hydrogen station in Warsaw is planned.

Increasing number of Poland's population in range of 5G Ultra network from Plus

Plus network (Polsat Plus Group) has announced that more than 4.2 million Polish residents in 171 towns and cities are already within the range of the 5G Ultra network launched about a month ago, and the number of 5G Ultra base stations is close to 700.

Users of 5G Ultra are able to enjoy mobile Internet at fiber-optic speeds. The technology used uses aggregation of three radio bands - two in 5G technology (2600 MHz and 2100 MHz) and additionally a 4G layer (1800 MHz) - for high-speed data transmission.

In total, there are more than 20 million people nationwide in the Plus network's 5G coverage.

Broadband market is less price-sensitive

The Telko.in portal conducted an interview with **Jolanta Dudek, Orange Polska's Vice President for Mass Market**, which shows that the entire market - operators, customers and the regulator - are coping with the difficult macroeconomic environment and the problem of inflation with the widespread price increase trend continuing in the market for the fifth year.

In an interview with the portal, Jolanta Dudek pointed out that while price is and will continue to be an important criterion for customers in choosing a provider and the service itself, their approach looks slightly different depending on the service segment.

Mobile services have been under far greater price pressure for many years. Fixed services are treated by customers on a long-term basis due to the need for installation. Therefore, in their case, quality parameters such as bandwidth, reliability and stability are more important selection criteria. Orange estimates that in the mix of purchasing factors, price is about 3 times more important for mobile services. In the mobile segment, on the other hand, the element of benefits considered against the market such as good network coverage or a high mobile data package is important in customers' purchasing decisions.

According to Jolanta Dudek, the prices of telecommunications services have been raised by all the major operators on the Polish market for a number of years, which does not collide with customer disapproval as long as the level of increases is not exorbitant. She also pointed out that telecommunications services have become a necessity good, and their prices in Poland are, despite the increases, relatively cheaper compared to other European Union countries.

The challenge for the market is to find a balance between large cost increases in a high-inflation environment and slower service price increases. Hence the need to constantly improve the efficiency of operators and pay attention to opportunities to reduce costs.


