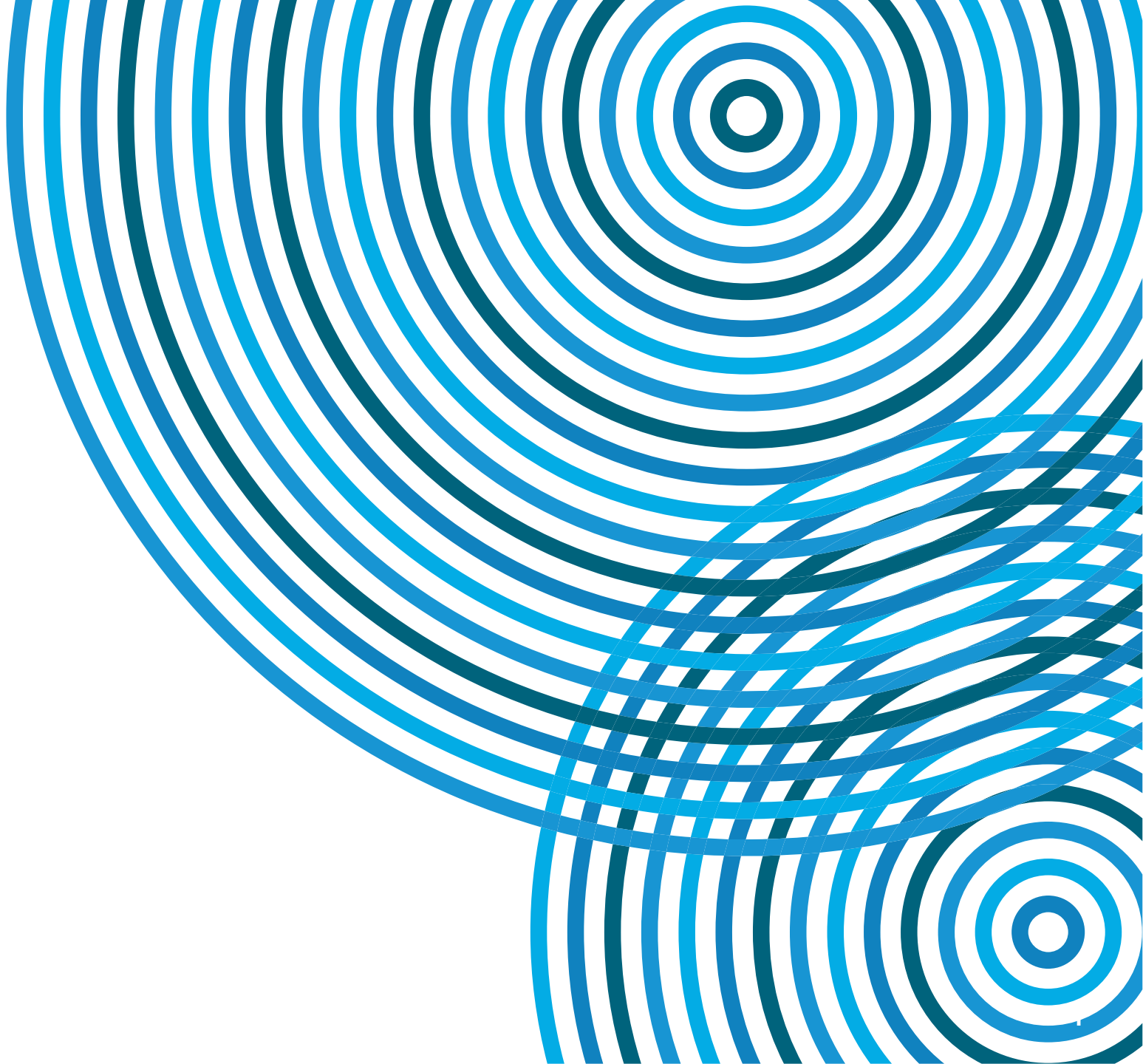

Mobile Internet in Poland in 2023. There could be only one winner

SpeedTest has presented the results of the Internet speed test for 2023. The mobile ranking relied on 3.5 million tests in 3G, 4G LTE and 5G networks performed while using Android and iOS speed test apps.

Plus, with the data speed of 49.3 Mbps, is the winner in the mobile Internet speed ranking for 2023. Plus was followed by T-Mobile (46.1 Mbps), Play (44 Mbps) and Orange (43.5 Mbps).

As regards the 5G network, Plus has been the unquestioned leader for the third time in a row, achieving average download speed of 134.6 Mbps. Play ranked second (72.2 Mbps), followed by Orange (69.1 Mbps).

378.3 thousand mobile numbers were ported between networks in Q4 2023, according to UKE

The Office of Electronic Communications (UKE) informed that 378.3 thou. MSISDN numbers were ported between mobile networks in the fourth quarter of 2023. The best net MNP balances among the four biggest MNOs and their subsidiaries were achieved by P4 (+31.9 thou. MSISDNs). Further spots were taken by T-Mobile Polska (+9.3 thou.), Orange Polska (-13.1 thou.) and Polsat Plus Group (-47.7 thou.).

A total of 1,464 thou. mobile numbers were ported in 2023 between networks. P4 achieved the best number porting balance (+124 thou. customers). Loss in terms of number porting was posted by Polkomtel (-207 thou. customers) and Orange Polska (-45 thou.).

Polsat News Polityka TV channel has been launched. The shows will be anchored by Szubartowicz, Maślankiewicz and Dąbrowski

Polsat News Polityka (Polsat News Politics) TV channel has been launched. The TV station's offer will include current affairs programs as well as news from Polish Parliament and coverage of Parliament sessions, both Lower and Upper house (Sejm and Senate). Also the hearings held by the parliamentary committees of inquiry will be broadcast.

“We are seeing growth of interest in politics and current affairs. These are the topics that stirred interest in Poland in recent months. The record turnout during the elections demonstrated that Poles want to be active in influencing the developments in politics”, says Piotr Witwicki, the Director of the news and journalism department in Polsat TV.

In the pay TV operators' channel lineup Polsat News Polityka replaced Wydarzenia 24 channel. Wydarzenia 24 is in turn building its coverage anew. The channel will be now broadcast based on the new terrestrial TV license (Polsat TV won the contest invited by the TV and radio regulator, KRRiTV) via MUX 1 multiplex. Wydarzenia 24 has so far been available via terrestrial TV but on MUX 4, which is managed by Polsat Plus Group.
