

Telecommunication market in Poland is worth PLN 41 billion and continues to grow

According to the estimates of PMR analytic company, Polish telecommunication market was worth PLN 41.1 billion in 2020 (+1.3% yoy). The market's growth is the outcome of good results achieved by operators in such segments as mobile telephony, Internet access and pay TV.

PMR forecasts that the average annual growth rate for the period 2021-2026 will be at the level of 0.4%, however some decline is expected in the short term (2021-2022). According to PMR the factors fostering telecommunication market growth include the "more-for-more" strategy pursued by the operators (i.e. offering more services in bundles at higher prices), focus on the quality of provided services as well as 5G network roll-out and sale of 5G tariffs.

In addition, the factors affecting market value growth include growing demand for broadband links in connection with COVID-19, investments in fiber-optic networks, market consolidation, convergence of services and bundling of telecom services with other services, including pay TV.

PMR estimates the total number of services (RGUs) in Poland at 80 million, with vast majority of these being postpaid (subscription) services.

Majority of the RGUs are mobile services (mobile telephony has also the biggest prospects of growth in term of the number of RGUs in the years 2021-2026). Further spots are occupied by Internet access and pay TV.

T-Mobile offers unlimited 5G Internet access with monthly fees starting from 45 PLN

T-Mobile Polska has launched a new Internet access offer which includes two tariffs offering access in 5G technology without data limits.

The first of the new tariffs (*M Nielimitowana – M Unlimited*) offers unlimited Internet access with the maximum data speed of up to 30 Mbps for PLN 45 monthly.


The second tariff (L Nielimitowana – L Unlimited) means unlimited data and uncapped data speed for PLN 65 monthly.

All the Internet access tariffs offered by the operator include unlimited voice calls, SMSs and MMSs. In addition the tariffs with higher access fees offer discounts on equipment, while the two 5G unlimited Internet access packages offer, for some defined time, access to content from subscription-based platforms.
