Orange begins gigabit fibre tests

Wojciech Jabczyński, spokesperson for Orange Poland, announced that the company has started commercial tests of the Pro 10.0 fibreoptic cable.

During the tests, upload speeds are expected to be up to 1 Gb/s and the target offering is planned to start in Q1 2024.

Orange is raising prices. This time it's not about inflation

Orane Polska has raised the prices of all its plans in its 5G mobile offer. All packages include unlimited calls, SMS and MMS-in the country and in EU roaming, as well as various data packs. The price of each in the first 24 months of the contract increased by PLN 5 per month, the price from the 25th month onwards was left unchanged.

The packages are currently as follows:

- Plan S 5G PLN 60 per month (PLN 70 from the 25th month),
- Plan M 5G PLN 70 per month (PLN 80 from the 25th month),
- Plan L 5G PLN 90 per month (PLN 100 from the 25th month)

UKE: average monthly bill for fixed-line Internet is PLN 67.4 and for mobile Internet PLN 46.3

According to a survey conducted by UKE (Electronic Communications Office) in 2023, 97 per cent of Poles say they use mobile telephony, 79 per cent of whom use the Internet on their phone. 78 per cent of those using telco services have encountered the term 5G.

The average cost of Internet access among respondents was PLN 67.40/mth for fixed access and PLN 46.30/mth for mobile access. The vast majority of respondents considered their cost to be affordable.

27 per cent of fixed Internet respondents were in the 100-299 MB/s speed range, followed by 26 per cent in the 300-599 MB/s range. Only 5 per cent of respondents had access to speeds above 1 GB/s, and one in four respondents could not specify the speed of their connection.

T-Mobile Poland assumes improved operational and financial performance in 2024 (interview)

T-Mobile Poland CEO Andreas Maierhofer has announced that the company anticipates growth in the B2C and B2B areas in 2024. He assumes an improvement in all key operational and financial indicators, while anticipating high level of inflation, yet lower than in previous years affecting the costs of the business.

He also highlighted the difficulties that the telecoms industry encountered in the first half of 2023. However, he believes that the business managed to get back on track in the second part of the year and views the whole of 2023 positively.

The CEO also recalled the 5G auction that ended in December, indicating that T-Mobile plans to have 1,400 of its own stations with access to this frequency in the near future, and including NetWorks shared stations there will be more than 2,000 of them. The company is expected to spend most of its PLN 1 billion annual investment on this, achieving coverage of 26 per cent of Poland's population.

The interviewee also commented on the fine imposed by UOKIK on T-Mobile, of over PLN 25 million, which he disagrees with, pointing out that it is disproportionate.
