Are telecoms in for a broadband growth of sales in 2022?

In their latest “Barometr sektorowy 2022” (2022 Sector Barometer) report, Pekao S.A. analysts have favorably assessed the development prospects of ICT for this year.

In their opinion, the development of this sector, which is one of the sectors that are most resistant to the pandemics, should be supported by “the ambitious digital targets” that the European Commission set for 2030.

In terms of its position in the Digital Economy and Society Index (DESI), Poland is still below the European average in many areas. This means the need for further growth of expenditures on data communication technologies in the broad sense of the term. The funds offered by European development programs should help here.

The bank’s analysts also expect that 2022 will be the year of substantial growth of corporate spending on information technologies in connection with the necessity of adapting to operations in the new, increasingly virtual reality.

The government will offer 100 PLN for a new set-top box. How to get the subsidy?

The government has adopted the draft act to subsidize the cost of TV set-top boxes that households will have to incur as a result of change of the broadcasting standard for digital terrestrial TV.

The change of the broadcasting standard, from DVB-T/MPEG-4 to the more efficient DVB-T2/HEVC, will take place in 2022. It is an element of the EU-wide change process.

Around 2.27 million households in Poland are not ready for digital terrestrial TV. For them change of the system to DV-T2/HEVC will mean the necessity of replacing the TV set to a newer model, or buying a DVB-T set-top box.

The adopted draft act provides for subsidizing the purchase of a set-top box with an amount of 100 PLN for the households which will declare that due to their difficult financial situation they will not be able to adapt their TV sets to the change of the broadcasting standard without obtaining the subsidy.
