UPC Polska demonstrates revenue and profit growth in 2021. The operator has 1.57 million customers

In 2021 UPC Polska cable network generated 454.8 million US dollars of revenue (+4.6% yoy), and net profit of 82.6 million USD (compared to 58.4 million USD a year earlier), with the adjusted EBITDA reaching 210 million USD.

At the end of December 2021 the operator was providing services (RGU's) to 1.57 million customers. Internet access was used by 1.35 million customers, while TV access service by 1.397 million customers.

T-Mobile in 2021: more customers, growth of key financial indicators

T-Mobile Polska reported revenue of 6.5 billion PLN (+0.9% YoY) and EBITDA AL of 1.76 billion PLN (+4.6% YoY). The number of customers the company served at the end of 2021 was 11.5 million (+344 thousand YoY).

Customer base of fiber-optic access services increased to nearly 70 thousand, with ca. 4.7 million households currently located within the coverage area of T-Mobile's fiber-optic network.

The operator also recorded growing demand for data transmission, up by 19% YoY, which included growth of video content-related data by 20% YoY, currently accounting for half of all data transmission in T-Mobile network.

- New promotional rate of PLN 0.19 per-minute for calls to all networks in Ukraine it is available for users of all prepaid and postpaid offers launched from 31 January 2018 onwards.
- Free, one-off 10 GB data bundle for use for data transmission on the territory of Poland. In the case of prepaid offers it is activated by entering the USSD code *136*11*9999# and pressing the call button. In the case of postpaid offers it is activated by sending an SMS saying 10GB to number 80125, and it remains active until the end of the first full bill cycle.

All the call packs mentioned above will be available from today. Plus na Kartę dedicated prepaid offer for customers from Ukraine also continues to be available. While using this offer, in return for a fee of 35 PLN customers are offered 30-day recurrent bundles which include:

- 1. unlimited domestic calls for 0 PLN to all mobile and fixed-line networks in Poland;
- 2. unlimited domestic SMS and MMS messages for 0 PLN to all domestic mobile networks;
- 3. a 15 GB data bundle for domestic data transmission;
- 4. 1000-minute call pack for international voice calls from Poland to Ukraine, to Kyivstar, Vodafone and Lifecell subscribers.

The promotion, which is called "Rozmowy, SMS-y, MMS-y bez limitu, 15 GB i 1000 minut na Ukrainę" (Unlimited voice calls, SMS's and MMS's as well as 15 GB of data and 1000 minutes for calls to Ukraine) can be activate by sending an SMS saying "35" to number 80988. Customers from Ukraine also have access to a dedicated help line in Ukrainian which operates from 8 a.m. to 4.p.m. on all days of week at phone number 601102614.


