

## T-Mobile Expands "5G More". Year-End Summary

In 2024, T-Mobile significantly expanded its "5G More" network, launching a total of 3,440 base stations in the C-band. As a result, the operator provides coverage for one-third of Poland's population. T-Mobile plans further network expansion in 2025. The goal is to increase service availability in smaller towns, allowing for even broader use of 5G technology across the country. The operator emphasizes that the development of the "5G More" network is crucial for the future of mobile communication in Poland, as well as for the growth of the digital economy.

### Number Portability Statistics for Q3 2024 and the Entire Year 2024

In mobile networks, over 430,000 numbers were ported in Q4 2024, an increase of more than 65,000 compared to Q3. As a result of number portability, Orange Polska lost 28,455 SIM card users, Polkomtel (operator of the Plus network) lost 1,878, T-Mobile ended the quarter losing 10,434 users, while P4 (operator of the Play network) gained 16,972 SIM card users. Throughout 2024, a total of over 1.5 million numbers were ported, an increase of nearly 48,000 compared to 2023. In fixed networks, nearly 76,000 numbers were ported in Q4 2024, and over 250,000 numbers were ported throughout the entire year.

### **Orange: Traffic is Increasing. 5G Accounts for 7.5% of Data Transmission**

Network traffic growth at Orange in 2024. Customers transmitted a total of 10.26 million TB of data, which is a 13% increase compared to 2023. The fixed network accounted for 7.70 million TB, with 80% transmitted via fiber optics. In the mobile network, 2.56 million TB of data were transmitted, and 5G accounted for 7.5% of data transmission, which is a result of the launch of 5G in the C-band. Orange already has over 3,000 5G stations.

### PMR: In 2024, the Telecommunications Market in Poland Was Worth 56 Billion PLN

PMR Market Experts estimated that in 2024, the value of the telecommunications market in Poland reached 56 billion PLN, which is a 2% increase compared to the previous year. However, the growth rate was lower than in previous years, mainly due to declines in fixed-line telephony, stagnation in pay TV, and weaker performance of mobile operators.

Fiber-optic services are gaining importance, accounting for more than half of all access lines in the country. Mobile telephony generated more than half of the revenues in the telecommunications market, but its share decreased due to reductions in MTR rates and a decline in the wholesale market value. Despite this, mobile operators recorded revenue growth, mainly thanks to the monetization of 5G services.

The expansion of broadband infrastructure remains a priority, and the number of households within reach of this infrastructure is growing dynamically. However, this does not directly translate into an increase in the number of subscribers, as some users do not see the need to use high-speed connections.

### Polsat-Interia Group Internet Leader in 2024

Polsat-Interia Group is the number one Internet publisher in Poland for 2024. According to Mediapanel research, Interia, together with Polsat's web services, achieved the highest reach (RU) five times in the last twelve months, the most in the market. In December, Polsat-Interia Group, with a result of 20.72 million RU, surpassed RAS Polska Group, Onet (20.63 million RU), and Wirtualna Polska Group (20.60 million RU).

Polsat-Interia Group most frequently held the top spot among Internet publishers in Poland in 2024. According to Mediapanel research, it was the market leader in January (21.11 million RU), April (20.91 million RU), May (20.46 million RU), and November (20.81 million RU). The publisher of Interia, Polsatnews.pl, and Polsatsport.pl also closed the year with the best result (20.72 million RU) in December.

Besides Polsat-Interia Group, Wirtualna Polska Group also won five times in 2024.

Polsat-Interia Group is the undisputed leader on the mobile platform in 2024. According to Mediapanel research, it outperformed other publishers nine times. It achieved the best result in this category during the periods January – June and October – December. Polsat-Interia Group also generated the highest average monthly reach on the mobile platform (19.19 million RU).

The publisher of Interia dominated popular thematic categories over the last twelve months. Pomponik.pl is the leader of 2024 among show-business services, and Deccoria.pl is number one in the "Interior and Garden" category. Zielona Interia is once again the most popular ecological service in Poland for another consecutive year.
