## The windmill law is back. What will be the distance of windmills from households?

The Ministry of Climate and Environment has announced a draft amendment to the Act on Renewable Energy Sources (RES). The ministry said that the minimum distance of windmills from developments will increase from 300 to 500 meters, which will be included in the amendment to the Windmill Investment Act.

The draft law on RES is aimed at aligning domestic law with EU regulations on state aid, speeding up the permitting process and introducing favorable changes to the prosumer system. The ministry noted that the Act on Nature Protection optionally allows activities that may affect Natura 2000 sites if overriding public interests warrant it. However, the ban on locating wind power plants in these areas remains in effect.

Deputy head of the Ministry of the Environment, Milosz Motyka, announced that consultations on the draft amendment to the so-called Windmill Law will begin soon. Currently, 17% of the country's land area is available for the location of onshore wind farms, and with the new regulations this potential could rise to 24-25%. Motyka stressed that the construction of wind farms should be done in harmony with the local community and in cooperation with local governments, which will bring benefits in the form of cheaper electricity and additional income. Poland's energy transition is to proceed fairly, respecting the needs of local communities.

## **PLN 1.8 million from Polsat for flood victims. Thanks to commercials**

During the broadcast of the charity advertising block “Advertising to the Rescue. Together for flood victims!” TV Polsat collected nearly PLN 1.8 million, with the support of 30 companies. In addition, Polsat Foundation has set up a special collection to help flood victims, which currently already amounts to PLN 3 million and is still ongoing. Charity advertising blocks were also broadcast by TVP and TVN, earmarking the proceeds for the flood victims. TVP collected more than PLN 2 million, while TVN collected PLN 2.9 million.

## **Copyright amendment in Poland. Newspaper publishers gain strength in fight against online platforms**

An amendment to the copyright law has gone into effect, granting press publishers the exclusive right to exploit their publications online through online platforms. This means that media outlets can now demand payment from big tech companies for editorially created material that generates traffic and advertising revenue on big tech platforms.

The amendment implements Article 15 of the EU's Directive on Copyright and Related Rights in the Digital Single Market (DSM Directive). In response, one of the big tech platforms restricted posts with links to press publications and did not post images or text excerpts, while another platform said there was “no clarity on the application of the new regulations.”

## **UKE with new powers. Telecoms will be penalized for failing to protect against spoofing**

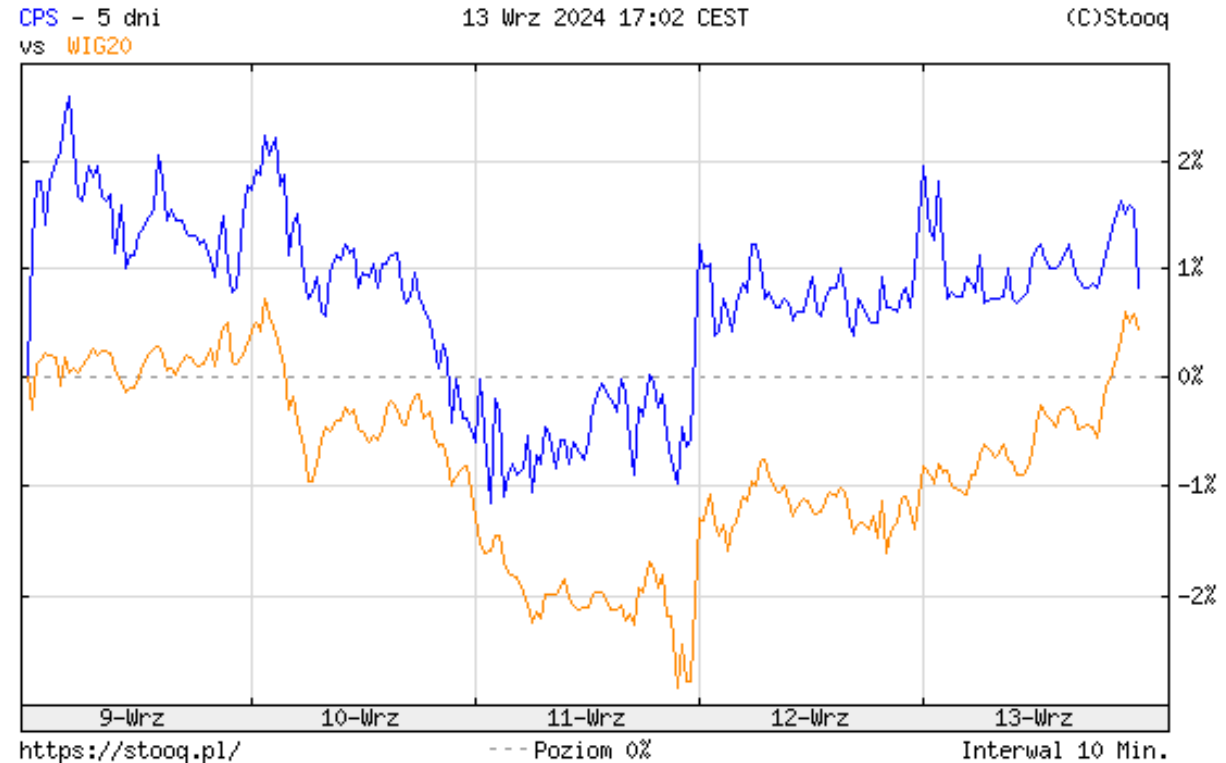
It's been a year since the Act on Combating Fraud in Electronic Communications came into force, which aims to counter the most popular methods of phishing for personal data, passwords and money by cybercriminals, such as spoofing (impersonating public trust institutions) and smishing (fake SMS and e-mail messages).

Since last week, the law has obliged telecommunications companies to block calls from collect-only numbers, such as helplines of banks or insurance companies. A list of these numbers is maintained by the UKE. For several months, telecoms have also been obliged to block SMS messages that conform to patterns from NASK's CSIRT database. It includes messages reported by recipients to the toll-free number 8080 or detected by NASK. Clicking on a link contained in such messages can install malware or redirect to phishing websites. NASK places the addresses of these sites on a warning list.

In the final stage of the law's implementation, the Office of Electronic Communications was given the power to punish telecoms for failing to block fraudulent phone calls.
