

Orange is testing 5G SA. This is true 5G, independent of LTE

Orange Polska has launched tests of the 5G SA (Standalone) network. The goal is to verify the technology before its commercialization, particularly in terms of FWA (Fixed Wireless Access) services and B2B solutions.

In the first phase, the basic network functions are being tested: data transmission, security, mobility, and interoperability with LTE. Orange is also testing slicing mechanisms, which allow the creation of virtual networks tailored to the needs of specific customer groups — such as gamers or emergency services. The company is also exploring the use of 3600 MHz and 700 MHz frequencies.

According to Piotr Jaworski, Member of the Management Board of Orange responsible for network and technology, full commercialization of 5G SA is planned for 2026, following certification with major terminal providers. In the future, 5G SA is expected to become the primary technology, alongside the gradual phase-out of LTE.

The Prime Minister has nominated a candidate for the position of President of the Office of Electronic Communications (UKE)

Prime Minister Donald Tusk has recommended Przemysław Kuna for the position of President of the Office of Electronic Communications (UKE). His candidacy has been formally submitted to the Polish Parliament. Przemysław Kuna previously served as Undersecretary of State at the Ministry of the Interior and sat on the boards of telecommunications companies, including Telnap Telecom and N3net.

He currently holds the position of Deputy Director at NASK (National Research Institute), where he is responsible for the development of the National Educational Network — a key project for the digitalization of Polish education. UKE, as a state institution, regulates the telecommunications and postal markets, allocates radio frequencies, monitors service quality, and protects consumer interests, including through interventions in disputes with operators.

Fiber reaches more cities. PSO expands coverage by 46,000 addresses

Polski Światłowód Otwarty (PŚO) significantly expanded its coverage in August 2025, reaching an additional 46,000 households. As part of the investment, over 19,000 new addresses were added to the network across 46 locations. Additionally, more than 27,000 homes and apartments were upgraded from HFC technology to the FTTH standard.

The new investments covered both large cities and smaller towns. PŚO operates exclusively in a wholesale model, cooperating with nine operators, including national providers (Play, T-Mobile, Netia, Plus, Orange) and local ones (RFC, Flashnet, Netronik, Intertell).

Thanks to the implementation of XGS-PON technology, retail operators can offer FTTH Internet with speeds of up to 8 Gb/s. Ultimately, PŚO plans to extend fiber coverage to over 6 million households across Poland.

Polsat Plus Group has completed installation work in Drzeżewo on the third largest wind farm in Poland

Commercial launch of the 139 MW Drzeżewo unit coming soon

Polsat Plus Group has completed installation works on the third-largest wind farm in Poland, which is also the Group's largest wind farm to date — the 139 MW Drzeżewo project. All 63 turbines have been installed, and the project is currently undergoing technical commissioning. Full commercial operation of the farm — whose estimated annual output will cover the electricity needs of approximately 180,000 households — is planned for Q4 this year. Once operational, the Drzeżewo wind farm will double Polsat Plus Group's wind power generation capacity.

Since 2021, Polsat Plus Group has been consistently implementing its Strategy 2023+ and developing a new business segment — green energy. Thanks to dynamic investments, the Group has quickly become a leading producer of energy from renewable sources.

Construction of the Drzeżewo wind farm began 18 months ago. The project comprises 63 wind turbines located in the municipalities of Potęgowo and Główczyce in the Pomeranian Voivodeship. The turbine nacelles are mounted at heights of 100 and 120 meters, with total turbine heights (including blades) of 150 and 175 meters. The rotor diameters are 100 and 110 meters, and each turbine has a capacity of 2.2 MW.
