

MC proposes that fiber optic infrastructure be mandatory also in single-family homes

Equipping buildings with fiber optic infrastructure will become mandatory also for single-family homes, according to the published assumptions for the draft amendment to the so-called "mega law," which have been listed in the government's legislative work schedule. The new regulations aim to align Polish law with the EU's GIA regulation from April 2024, which mandates that new or thoroughly renovated buildings be equipped with fiber optic infrastructure starting from February 12, 2026.

The goal of these changes is to accelerate, simplify, and reduce the costs of deploying very high-capacity networks across the EU.

The amendment also provides for exceptions, such as for historic buildings, and introduces the requirement to attach a declaration regarding telecommunications installations during building acceptance. The draft also proposes simplifying administrative procedures, shortening proceedings to 30 days, and expanding the functionality of UKE's Telecommunications Information Point to facilitate contract signing and access to information. Additionally, a maximum fee will be set for placing telecommunications infrastructure on internal roads, along with other improvements to the investment process for gigabit networks.

Interia Mail introduces a revolutionary feature. No one else offers such convenience

Interia has added a new, revolutionary feature to its email service – recurring BLIK payments within the "Bills in Mail" service. This allows users to automatically pay monthly bills (e.g., for electricity, gas, water, phone, internet, or subscriptions) without manually initiating each transfer. All it takes is a one-time activation of the service by confirming it with a BLIK code in the banking app. Subsequent payments will be processed automatically or – depending on the settings – require confirmation in the banking app.

The new feature is available to users of Interia mailboxes (both free and paid versions like Mail Without Ads and MailPRO) who use the "Bills" folder and have an account with one of the banks supporting recurring BLIK payments (including PKO BP, Millennium, Santander, SGB, ING, Nest Bank, Alior Bank). Activation is free of charge, with BillBird as the service operator and Polski Standard Płatności as the technology provider.

Thanks to this solution, Interia has become the first portal in Poland to offer such a convenient and automated way to handle recurring bill payments directly from the mailbox, significantly enhancing user comfort and improving control over household finances.

Five years that transformed the telecommunications and postal market

Jacek Oko, President of Office of Electronic Communications (UKE), summarizes his five-year term and the most significant changes in the telecommunications and postal market between 2020 and 2025.

During this period, the market underwent a profound transformation. One of the key achievements was regulatory stabilization – a systemic approach was introduced for both fixed and mobile services, including enabling operators to use energy infrastructure, which accelerated network development. On the wholesale market, guidelines were aligned with EU standards, and price caps were introduced for broadband investments funded by public resources. The deregulation process for BSA (Bitstream Access) also began, increasing competition.

In the mobile sector, two major frequency auctions were held: for the 3.4–3.8 GHz band (C-band) and the 700/800 MHz bands – setting a clear course toward 5G network development. Existing resources were reorganized through two reshuffling processes (900 MHz and 1800 MHz). Thanks to consensus reached with operators, the bands were consolidated, allowing for higher-quality services. Additionally, the President of UKE proposed a unified mechanism for synchronizing frequency reservations, which improved transparency and predictability for operators.

UKE also actively promoted digital education and worked to combat digital exclusion – hundreds of thousands of children, youth, and seniors were trained in online safety, data protection, and recognizing manipulation on social media. Coding classes were also introduced to develop digital skills and logical thinking.

Polsat Plus Group awarded in the 1st edition of POLSIF Awards – recognition for innovative financing supporting green transformation

Polsat Plus Group (GPP) has been honored with a prestigious award in the 1st edition of the POLSIF Awards, organized by the Sustainable Investment Forum Poland (POLSIF). The competition jury, composed of financial market and ESG experts, awarded GPP in the category "Best Sustainability-Linked Financing," appreciating the issuance of corporate bonds linked to sustainable development goals.

The award was received during a gala ceremony held on September 17 at the Warsaw Stock Exchange by Eryk Walkiewicz, Director of the Treasury and Financial Policy Department, and Marek Napierała, Head of the Group's Financing Management Team. The award was presented by PwC representative, Łukasz Żochowski.

The awarded bonds were issued under series D, E, and F, with a total nominal value of nearly PLN 3.9 billion, with a maturity date in January 2030. The funds raised from the issuance were allocated, among other things, to the development of projects in the green energy segment, in line with the *Polsat Plus Group Strategy* 2023+.

The bonds are fully compliant with the international ICMA standard and are linked to the goal of gradually increasing the share of zeroemission energy in the Group's energy mix. Sustainability-Linked Bonds are a modern form of financing that integrates business goals with actions for sustainable development – environmental, social, and corporate governance (ESG).
