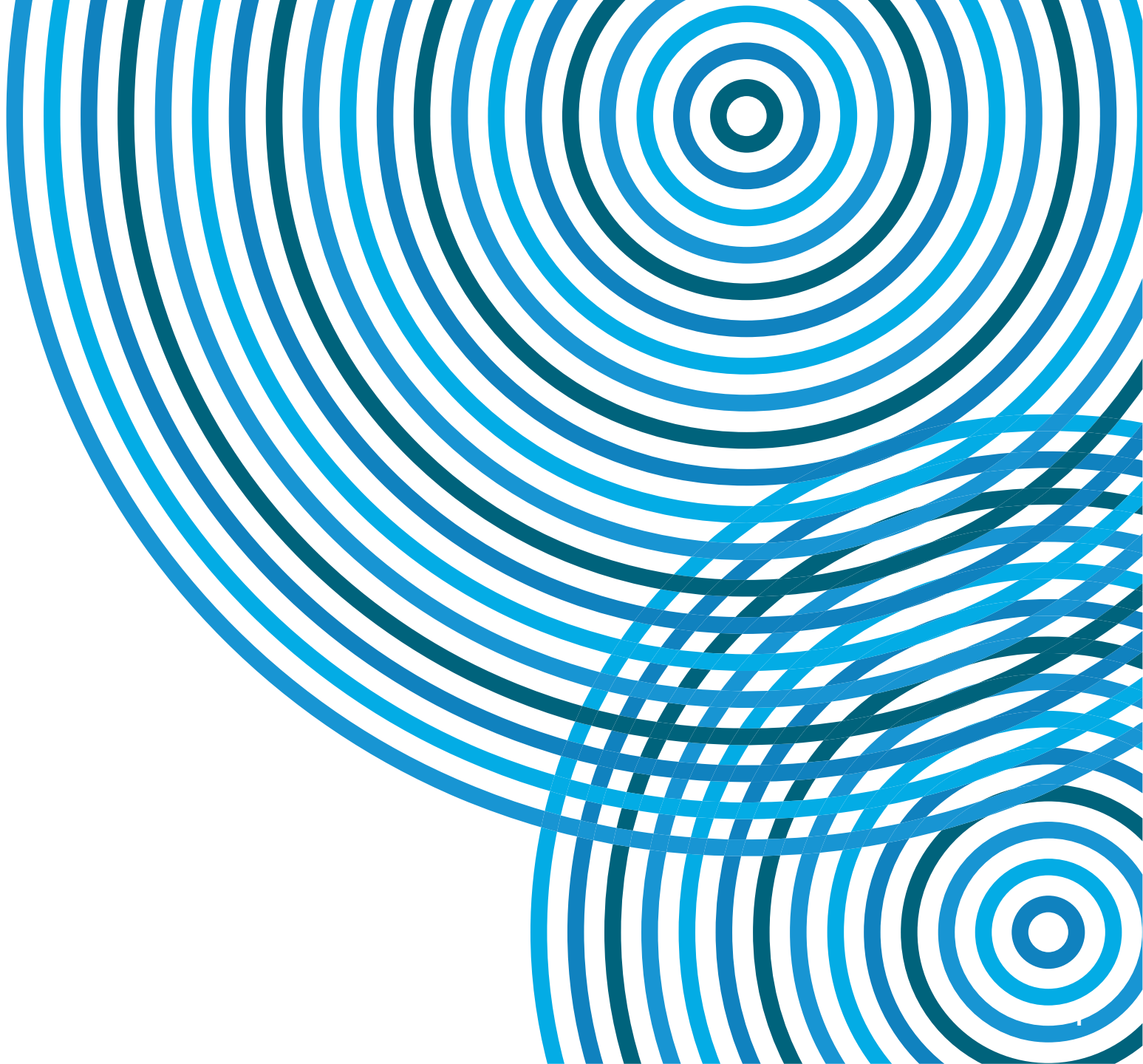

## Number Portability Statistics in Q1 2026

In the first quarter of 2026, the Polish telecommunications market continued to see a high level of number portability activity, although lower than in the previous quarter. According to data from the Office of Electronic Communications (UKE), a total of 379.4 thousand mobile numbers were ported, representing a decline of around 73 thousand compared with Q4 2025. This trend is consistent with market seasonality, as year-end periods traditionally see increased subscriber migration. In terms of net balance, Orange Polska clearly outperformed its peers, increasing its number of SIM cards by 17.1 thousand. T-Mobile recorded a marginal increase, while the remaining infrastructure-based operators reported net losses, with Polkomtel experiencing the largest customer outflow.

In the fixed-line segment, 71.8 thousand numbers were ported, also fewer than in the previous quarter. Overall, the data confirm continued competitive pressure in the market and a growing willingness among customers to change operators in search of more attractive offers, increasingly beyond the traditional top four players.

## Plus Changes Contracts: Free Gigabytes for Thousands of Customers

Polkomtel, the operator of the Plus mobile network, has announced significant changes to the terms and conditions of its services, which will come into force on 10 May 2026. The changes result from recommendations issued by the President of the Office of Electronic Communications (UKE) requiring operators to withdraw from the so-called zero-rating model. This means the end of free data usage for selected applications such as Facebook, Instagram, Messenger, WhatsApp, YouTube and TikTok. From May onwards, data traffic generated by these services will be deducted from customers' standard data allowances.

As compensation, Plus will introduce free, recurring data packages for selected customer groups. Users of Plus na Kartę and Plush na Kartę offers will receive an additional 40 GB, renewed every 30 days, while Plush Abonament customers will be granted a 50 GB package in each billing period. Smaller bonuses are provided for customers of internet-only offers. The changes mainly affect older contracts and do not apply to the entire customer base, while any unused gigabytes will not roll over to subsequent periods.

## Company Linked to Play Expands Its Network Reach to Over 4.5 Million Addresses

Polski Światłowód Otwarty (PŚO), an infrastructure company associated with the Play Group and partly originating from UPC Polska's assets, continues the dynamic expansion of its FTTH network. In March 2026, the network's reach increased by nearly 52 thousand households, including over 11 thousand connected through newly built infrastructure and more than 40 thousand as a result of upgrading the HFC network to full fibre.

The largest increases were recorded in major metropolitan areas, including Warsaw, Wrocław and Łódź, although investments also covered numerous medium-sized and smaller cities. In total, PŚO's network now reaches more than 4.5 million addresses across Poland, of which approximately 1.7 million are covered by FTTH infrastructure. The company operates exclusively under a wholesale model, providing network access to retail operators on non-discriminatory terms. The rollout is based on XGS-PON technology, enabling services with speeds of up to 8 Gb/s, and PŚO ultimately plans to extend FTTH coverage to more than 6 million households nationwide.

## **Change of the publication date of the annual report and consolidated annual report for the financial year 2025**

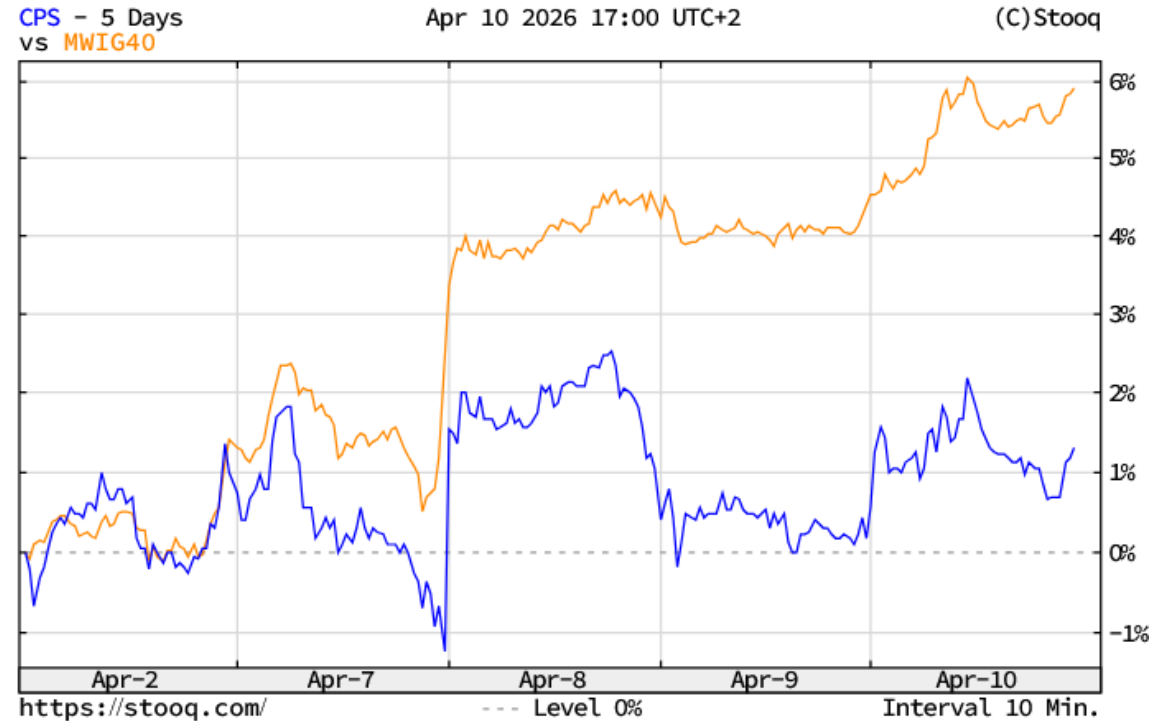
