UOKiK agrees to acquisition of Virgin Mobile Polska by Play

The President of the Office of Competition and Consumer Protection expressed consent to acquisition of 100% of shares of Virgin Mobile Polska (MVNO) by P4, the operator of Play network.

The acquisition price is EUR 13.4 million (ca. PLN 60.7 million).

Play assumes that while accounting for the integration costs and the anticipated synergies, the acquisition of Virgin Mobile Polska should have positive influence on the adjusted EBITDA and free cash flow for the company's shareholders within 24 months of finalization of the transaction.

According to the data from this spring, Virgin Mobile Polska had 420 thousand customers. In 2018 the company reported PLN 98.38 million of revenue (versus PLN 97.51 million a year earlier) and PLN 101.43 million of operating expenses (vs. PLN 118.58 million a year earlier). Net loss for 2018 was PLN 40.01 million (compared to a loss in the amount of PLN 21.8 million a year earlier).

Orange Polska GM in favor of allocating the profit for 2019 to reserve capital which could be used for dividend payout

The General Meeting of Orange Polska made a decision to allocate the company's net profit for 2019, in the amount of PLN 88.3 million, to reserve capital which could be used for dividend payout in the years to come.

In February the Management Board of Orange Polska informed that it would not recommend dividend payout in 2020. The most recent payout, in the amount of PLN 0.25 per share, was made in 2016.

“Wydarzenia” news program and Polsat News channels seen as providing most reliable information during the election campaign

Poles have recognized Polsat’s “Wydarzenia” (News) program and the Polsat News channel as the sources providing most reliable information during the presidential election campaign, according to a survey presenting the opinions of Polish citizens regarding the most popular TV programs which was conducted by IBRIS polling firm at the request of Onet.pl web portal.

“Wydarzenia” news program has been considered as reliable by 41.2% of the respondents. It was the best result of all the news programs covered by the survey. Polsat News channel, scoring 36.9%, ranked no. 2, ahead of other news channels (TVN24 and TVP Info) as well as ahead of the competitors’ news programs (TVN’s Fakty and TVP’s Wiadomości). Polsat’s Wydarzenia and Polsat News were followed by TVN24 (35.8%), Fakty TVN (35.1%) and TVP Info (21%), with the last spot going to TVP1’s Wiadomości main news program (17.5%).

“Above all I would like to thank the viewers for their trust and recognition for our work. Paraphrasing a certain statement – it’s worth being objective and independent. The opinion surveys of this type are particularly important for the journalists, since in such surveys we are being judged by the people for whom we make these programs, i.e. by the viewers. I can promise you that we will continue striving to be the most reliable in Polish media – it is an obligation we have to millions of our viewers,” says **Dorota Gawryluk, the Director of Information and Journalism in Polsat TV.**

“We are glad that once again our news programs have been recognized as most reliable according to opinion surveys and that they enjoy the trust of viewers. It is a merit of our fine team of journalists who work hard every day so as to provide objective presentation of the most important developments from Poland and from around the world,” says **Adam Nowe, a Member of the Management Board of Polsat TV.**

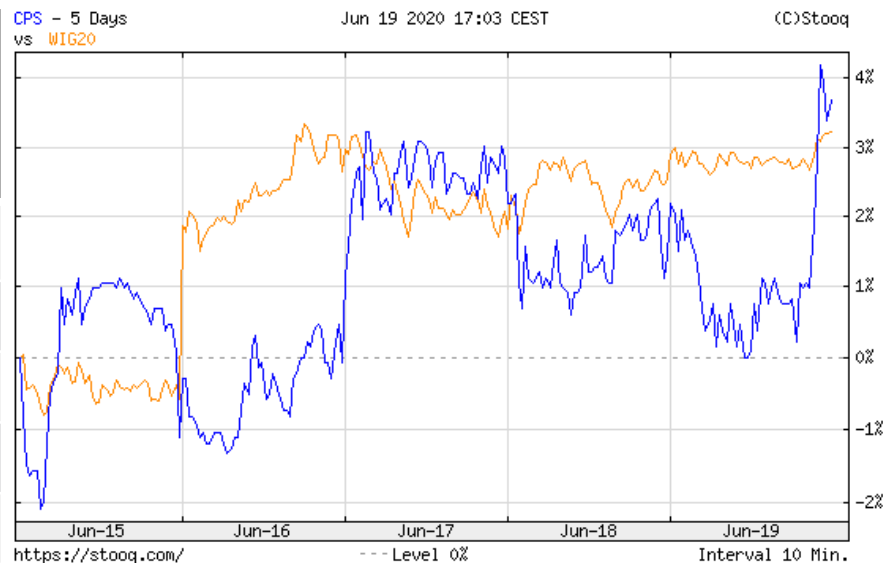
