Wirtualnemedia.pl 29 September 2020 Cyfrowy Polsat may use INEA fiber-optic lines by NB

INEA will allow Cyfrowy Polsat Group companies (Cyfrowy Polsat, Polkomtel and Netia) to access its open fiber-optic network which operates under the brand of Fiberhost. It is a network providing wholesale access for local and national telecom operators. Thanks to the agreement signed by Netia and INEA, ultimately Cyfrowy Polsat Group companies will be able to reach as many as 1.2 million households in Poland.

While commenting on the agreement, **Netia's CEO Andrzej Abramczuk** said that sharing of access infrastructure, especially in less urbanized areas, "was in his view a way to assure even richer offer of top quality multiplay services at affordable prices to the millions of Polish households, a significant part of which already use numerous services offered by Cyfrowy Polsat Group."

At the same time the companies signed a technological partnership agreement.

PAP BiznesUOKiK has obligated Play to repay the unconsumed funds from prepaid accounts28 September 2020by epo/asa

Office of Competition and Consumer Protection (UOKiK) has issued a decision which obligates Play to repay to its customers the unconsumed funds from prepaid accounts which have been retained on these accounts due to lack of further account top-ups.

Similar proceedings are in progress with regard to Orange Polska. Earlier T-Mobile made a commitment to change the practice while Polkomtel was penalized for similar practices.

Telko.in5G available in P30 September 2020by Marek Jaślan

5G available in Plus's prepaid service

Starting 1 October Polkomtel, a mobile operator who is member of Cyfrowy Polsat Group, extended the possibility of promotional use of 5G services to its prepaid customers using "Plus na Kartę" prepaid offer.

At present some 900 thousand people living in seven Polish cities, i.e. Warsaw, Gdansk, Katowice, Lodz, Poznan, Szczecin and Wroclaw can enjoy 5G network services, with the network's further roll out continuing.

Currently the Plus network's offer includes 10 smartphones and two routers which support 5G data transmission in the 2.6 GHz TDD frequency band.

UPC Polska has signed an agreement with Nexera by means of which it will be using Nexera's fiber-optic network, which was built as an element of the Digital Poland Operational Program, to offer access to its services. The cooperation will be carried out using the BSA (Bitstream Access) model.

Earlier similar agreements with Nexera were, among others, signed by T-Mobile, Orange Polska and Netia (Cyfrowy Polsat Group).

[Comment from the editor: the following current report has practical application solely to holders of the registered / preferred shares of the Company]

First Call of Cyfrowy Polsat S.A. for the submission of certificated shares of the Company for the purpose of their dematerialization

The Management Board of Cyfrowy Polsat S.A. (the "**Company**," "**Cyfrowy Polsat**"), acting pursuant to Article 16 of the Act of August 30, 2019 amending the Commercial Companies Code and certain other acts, calls on all shareholders who hold certificated shares of the Company to submit them in the Company's headquarters at street Łubinowa 4a, 03-878 Warsaw, Poland on business days (from Monday to Friday) from 7.00 am to 2.00 pm by January 15, 2021 at the latest.

In parallel, the Company informs that as of March 1, 2021 the binding force of the certificated shares issued by the Company in a paper form will cease to exist by virtue of law (ex lege) while records of the shares on securities accounts will become legally binding.


The submission of the shares after January 15, 2021 may result in a delay in registration of the shares by the securities depository (i.e., with effect after March 1, 2021). It should be stressed that after March 1, 2021 certificated shares will become solely evidence in proving ownership rights in the Company by a shareholder. Furthermore, after March 1, 2026 certificated shares will cease to represent evidential force mentioned in the previous sentence.

The Company notices that this call is the first of five required by law and that the submission of the certificated shares in the Company will be made against written confirmation of receipt issued to the shareholder.
