	16.02	Puls Biznesu: Generous Orange has recovered by mzat  The shares of Orange Polska gained more than 10% following the publication of Q4 results. It has been above all a reaction to the board's recommendation of payment of a dividend of PLN 0.5 per share. The market feared that the dividend could be reduced in the face of the expenditures related to the LTE spectrum auction. In Q4 Orange generated EBITDA of PLN 894m with revenue of PLN 3.087bn. For the current year the operator forecasts cash flow of PLN 900m and investments in fiber-optic lines (FTTH) at the level of PLN 450m (with the total CAPEX for the year planned at PLN 2bn.). Orange's CEO announced that the company intended to feed the FTTH network to 650 thousand households (today the company has 2.6 thousand customers using FTTH services).
	18.02	Rzeczpospolita: Bright future of pay TV by ele  ABI Research estimates that at the end of 2014 pay TV services had 924.4m customers worldwide, or 5% more than a year earlier. According to ABI Research analysts, IPTV was the fastest growing segment (up by 14%), followed by satellite platforms, seeing growth of 7%, and cable TVs (ca. 3%). On the one hand, the pay TV businesses are affected by Internet services, such as Netflix or Hulu, which take way customers from them. On other hand, packaging of services as well as new technology-driven functionalities, e.g. premium packages which offer sports or HD channels, slow down customer outflow from satellite platforms or enable them to maintain existing ARPU levels in spite of shrinking customer bases.

	19.02	Rzeczpospolita: Continued decline of tablet sales by Magdalena Lemańska  According to IDC Poland data, 2014 saw a 5% decline in the number of tablets sold, which was to a great extent the outcome of market saturation and competition from attractive, in terms of pricing, and much more functional notebooks. In the opinion of an IDC analyst, in spite of further decline of tablet prices sales slowdown is expected to continue.  According to Gartner, sales of tablets are slowing down because it is cannibalized by big screen smartphones which many users consider sufficient, e.g. for Internet browsing.
	20.02	Rzeczpospolita: TV Puls invests in production by Magdalena Lemańska  Puls TV, whose viewership has been increasing, has started investing more in programs, including its own productions. Dariusz Dąbski, CEO of Puls TV, informed that this year's investments in the development of programs will be more than twice last year's figure of PLN 50m. The revenue of the company, which broadcasts Puls and Puls 2 channels, is expected to surpass PLN 200m.  The company has not ruled out its participation in the contest for the new package of digital terrestrial TV channels. It is aiming at achieving an audience share of 7%.

	20.02	Parkiet: Netia – no official forecasts for 2015  by Urszula Zielińska  In 2014 Netia's revenue decreased by 11%, down to PLN 1.67bn, while the EBITDA margin (adjusted for one-time events) was 29.5%. The company announced that this year it will spend 12-13% of the 2015 revenue on investments, which means that in nominal terms its CAPEX spending will be lower than in 2014. The company has abandoned the practice of publishing forecasts.  The management board upheld the dividend policy which assumed payout of PLN 0.42 per share but has not presented any official recommendation so far.  The group's net profit for 2014 was PLN 174.8m, compared to PLN 46.3m last year, and it chiefly resulted from one-time events, including the settlement with Orange Polska and the repayment of unjustly paid tax. Netia's strengths include low debt (net debt at the level of PLN 93.2m and the net debt to adjusted EBIDTA ratio of 0.19).


